Other Important Dates

Monday, November 14, 2011

The Archdiocesan application card* will be made available to Catholic elementary schools Monday, November 15. The Catholic elementary schools will give their students the Archdiocesan application card.

Once the form is completed, return it to the Good Shepherd School, which will forward it, along with all of the required records, to the school of your choice.

*** The school of your choice may also require you to fill out a separate Application for Admission, specifically for that school. If so, it can usually be found at the school's website or you will receive it at that school's Open House.**

Wednesday, November 16, 2011

Catholic elementary schools collect the Archdiocesan application cards from their students (as well as the Application for Admission of their school of choice, if required).

Friday, November 18, 2011

The Good Shepherd School will send the following to your chosen school:

- Completed Archdiocesan application card
- Transcripts
- Standardized test results
- 1st quarter and 2nd quarter (if available) report card
- The Application for Admission to your school of choice, if required

December 2010

Your school of choice may send you information detailing the upcoming placement test process (see *High School Application Day* below). They may also conduct an interview with all prospective students.

Saturday, January 7, 2011 – High School Application Day

Students take the High School Placement Test (or equivalent) at their school of choice. This test has different purposes for different schools (for example, it can be used to place students in College Prep or Honors courses, to determine academic scholarships, and/or to help determine which students need help in a certain subject). Students will also pay a \$20 application fee to that school. **Students can only apply to one school; therefore, they can only attend one High School Application Day.**

January 2011

If they haven't already, your school of choice may conduct an interview with all prospective students.

Tuesday, February 14, 2011

Letters of acceptance (or rejection) are mailed out.

REMEMBER: A decision for your school of choice must be made by November 14th.
